

What can You do **TODAY** To **WIN THIS NOVEMBER?**

These four people can help us win more elections this year . . . with a little help from You. They pop up in Talk Radio Land (TRL) and influence many thousands of our fellow citizens across the USA. What is limiting their ability to help our candidates? Find out — when you read about the first person in the picture. [Hint: Reminding them about these numbers (1, 2, 5, and '17) is half the battle.]

In March and in April, **Jennifer Horn** thrilled America with her positive and enthusiastic broadcasts. (She filled in for a guy named Chris . . . and each time mentioned that she is from L.A.) **What two things did Jennifer miss?** First, she did NOT mention the need to toss Maxine Waters into the unemployment line. (U. S. Representative Waters is also from L.A.) NOR did Jennifer mention the number of jobs our Democrat friend helped prevent. She did *not* vote for the Republican bills to help create **One** Million Jobs early this century. [Like most Democrats, Marcy Kaptur and Sherrod Brown of Ohio also did *not* vote for the jobs. (Jennifer did not mention them to Ohio callers.))] Like other lefties, Maxine also voted for a man in 2008 who then *prevented* another **TWO** Million Jobs from being created. (His name is Barack.) These Democrats also voted *for* incredibly expensive energy policies. Why? They want to do BIG things to address the microscopic effect man has on climate. All together, these

policies will cost us **FIVE** Million More Jobs. Plus, e-v-e-r-y Democrat in Congress (including Marcy, Sherrod, and Maxine) voted *against* the **2017** Tax Cuts and Jobs Bill. That 2017 bill helped bring about the “lowest” unemployment rate in fifty years. (This news popped up on NBC’s *Meet the Press* on October 6, 2019.) Remember that Jennifer filled in for Chris. He replaced a national host named Hugh early in 2025. What did Hugh Hewitt miss?

In 2018 we needed to defeat Senator Debbie Stabenow of Michigan. On the 1st of February Hugh said he “had nothing against her.” **How did Hugh miss Deb’s bad votes (1, 2, 5, and ‘17)?** “Only the Shadow knows.” Much more famous hosts in TRL also had her good opponent on their shows. They mentioned Deb VS Mr. Trump. Yet, **NONE** mentioned Deb’s role in 1, 2, 5, and ‘17. * * Did You know this was the closest she ever came to losing her Senate seat? ? ?

[Some bad things JOE BIDEN signed into law passed by Deb’s **o-n-e** vote. The rest of this booklet has other lefties in close races . . . and folks in Talk Radio Land (TRL) missing opportunities to WIN.]

“Thanks” from I’m **Not** Newt.

Let’s compare the things done by current leaders with something good that Rush did. In 1994 Rush Limbaugh gave us a question to ask Democrats who did “Town Hall” events. (*Can you name one country that has taxed itself into prosperity?*) This and other activities of Rush helped us to gain many House and Senate seats. Now we jump to the Tall Guy in the picture.

In March of 2024 it was my pleasure to hear about 90% of a **Jesse Kelly** broadcast. On that day he mentioned that Chucky

Schumer wanted absolutely no cuts to the Federal budget. [[You may recall silly statements from Hakeem, Chucky, and other Leftists during the DOGE era of early '25. (*The world will end tomorrow because of Elon and any budget cut!*)]] Then, in May and in June of '24, Jesse was a guest of Clay and Buck. (The pair replaced our Dear Late El Rush Bo.) Never did he/or/they come close to mentioning 1, 2, 5, or '17 -or- anything else to help people listening to defeat Leftists. They failed to do this despite the fact that I sent an e-mail to Buck in 2010 about 1 and 5. [[In 2010 I sent a similar e-mail to Mark Levin, too, so he could help Christie.]] Here is **something worse** than the three guys not mentioning the numbers. **They didn't mention TAMMY OF WISCONSIN at all while discussing the 2024 Republican Convention.** (It was in Milwaukee which is still in Wisconsin the last time I looked.) Somehow Jesse and the guys did find plenty of time to "discuss" steak dinners/etc. in relation to the convention. * * Did You know that Sen. Baldwin only won reelection that year by about 1%? ?

It IS true that Clay and Buck had Eric, our good candidate running against Tammy, on their show a few times. **NONE of the hosts who had Eric on the air (Mark, Clay and Buck, others) mentioned Tammy's record. (1, 2, 5, and '17)** Of course, the voting records of CHUCKY SCHUMER (NY) and PATTY FLAKES MURRAY (WA) are identical. Then again, so are the records of LLOYD DOG-GONE DOGETT (TX) and MR. CLYBURN (SC). [Democrats vote pretty consistently . . . with Nancy Pelosi.]

By now You are starting to see just how easy it is to help our leaders on the right. **Just remind them to mention 1, 2, 5, and '17 . . . and to remember Marcy, Sherrod, Maxine, and a few others.**

You may have recognized my favorite member of Congress on the cover of this booklet. In 2005 I gave her the name **Marvelous Marsha Blackburn**. (Yes, she already had two of those names.) Starting (no-later-than) 2013 she's been a regular on the *Sean Hannity Show* and other programs in TRL. **UNTIL THE SUMMER OF**

2024 I NEVER HEARD HER BRING UP A HOUSE OR SENATE RACE. (She may have done so on days I missed.) Note that I

recently sent Marvelous and Jennifer my short/fun booklet *Rush, CHARLIE KIRK, and You!* from October, 2025. [I, Bob Chafield, sent copies via Facebook and e-mails to lots of candidates and to county/state Republican Parties. (Yes, I even mailed a few like the one to Greg VS Gabe in New Mexico and to Tano in Texas via Lilly and Co. of Austin . . . and to Marvelous.) A few candidates & outfits have thanked me.] < < You see why “I’m Not Newt,” right?

Finally, we come to the one person in the picture I have had the pleasure of meeting in person, **Col. Allen West**. In 2010 I first sent him ((and a guy that shared his office named MARCO)) a pamphlet. (I’ve produced them for candidates since the 2002 elections.) I’m encouraging people to write Col. West *because* he pops up on Bryan Kilmeade’s show. Bryan can reach many people across the USA who can talk to their contacts about 1, 2, 5, and ‘17. Though Bryan is an independent, he knows We Need Oil/a secure border/only girls in girls’ sports/etc. [This makes him different from Crazy Bernie’s political grandchildren. (One is the Marxist Mayor of New York. Another is The Congressional Cutie, or CC. She is also the star of *Thirty Going On Thirteen*. About every other time Rep. Occasio-Cortez opens her mouth she makes a MORE child-like statement.)]

Folks who hear about 1, 2, 5, and ‘17 via Bryan (or You) can also encourage Sean Hannity, Dana Loesch (our top female host) and others in Congress and TRL to do a bit more to help campaigns. [In January, 2012 I sent Dana a pamphlet via an e-mail. This was a month before she was at CPAC with The Next Jennifer.]

We can also encourage special guests on these shows to help us win, too. On February 16, 2012 I had a good conversation with Jennifer Stefano in PA. [She (was/or/is?) with a pro-economic freedom group.] Over the next few months she popped up often on Sean’s show. **She never mentioned the pamphlet I’d sent her.** Nor did she

mention the leftist we needed to defeat in her o-w-n state's U. S. Senate race. (**Sean didn't mention him, either.**)

The same day I called her, I talked to the campaign staff of **Ted Cruz**. The next day (Feb. 17) I mailed them my 2012 pamphlet. Somehow Ted forgot to mention the JOBS (1 and 5 by then) during his m-a-n-y times in TRL that year. [See why they need Your help?](#)

On October 18, 2012 I put into his hand a piece of paper that asked: "What is the easiest way to help Ted Cruz? Tell your friends in New Mexico to vote for Heather Wilson for the Senate." A week later Ted was on Robert Pratt's show from the Texas panhandle. T-h-e-y didn't mention Heather . . . despite the fact that **Pratt** sometimes talks about his New Mexico listeners **right next door**. * * Did you know that Heather was neck-and-neck with the Democrat? ? [She lost.]

Mark Davis recently hosted the show from page 1, too. Mike Gallagher was a guest. They never mentioned 1, 2, 5, and '17. Yet, Mike s-a-i-d that we need to defeat the Left. Hmm. [In 2008 I reached out to Mark about anti-job votes of Democrats. (The f-i-r-s-t time was via a fax just after he filled in for Rush on a Thursday in April. The next day he filled in again . . . and did not mention any of these votes to the lady from Michigan looking for a way to toss Leftists.)]

By the way, it has been my good pleasure to talk to a few college-aged folks recently. ((*Rush, CHARLIE KIRK, and You! Was* written for their age group . . . though it can be used to help anyone Win More Races.)) One point I make with these young citizens has to do with the "average" voter. Most are 30-or-above. Jesse Kelly said something important about these (potential) voters in 2024. Most CONSTRUCTION WORKERS/etc. fall into this crowd. They CAN SEE THAT WHEN LEFTISTS VOTE **AGAINST** JOB CREATION . . IT'S A VOTE AGAINST THEM, TOO! Yes, I handed a (U.S. House & Senate) pamphlet to **Ken Paxton** and one to **Gov. Abbott** before the March, 2024 Texas Primary Elections. **They did not mention 1, 2, 5, or '17** to Sean -or- Glenn Beck or whoever before the fall elections.

Until 2024, I never heard **Jim Jordan EVER** mention **Marcy or Sherrod** to Sean, Glenn, etc. [I first heard Jim with Sean in (?) 2011. Of course, this was before Sherrod was 1st up for reelection (2012) to the Senate. He did no better with **Marcy**. * * * Did you know she only won by about 1% in '24?? [[Defeat them NOW!](#) **1, 2, 5, & '17**]

On April 21, 2026 Buck said we MUST help Connecticut elect Republicans. His plan is to move 10,000 folks from Wyoming to the Nutmeg State. *They* will vote with us. True. You can look at just a few votes to help you decide who to support for Congress. (Remember that this person may be in Washington for decades.)

- Even two years after the 9/11 attacks our economy still needed a boost. On the 23rd of May, 2003 Congress voted on The Jobs and Growth Reconciliation Act. This bill provided tax cuts for individuals *and* for businesses to invest in new equipment, software, etc. Most House Democrats voted “NO” including (future-Speaker of the House) Nancy Pelosi. Also, most Senate Democrats said “NO” including (future-Senate Majority Leader) Chucky Schumer, Hillary Clinton, and Joe Biden. (Over 90% of Democrats voted “NO.”) 1

Republicans voted for it. How well did the plan work? “Economy has best showing in 20 years” was the headline of the Associated Press (AP) article at the end of October, 2003. That’s how the article by Jeannine Aversa described the quarter (July – September) *right after* the bill passed.

- The next chance the House had to vote for a major bill to help our economy was on November 18, 2003. The bill was H. R. 6 and it would have expanded access to clean burning natural gas and would have improved conservation efforts. “Cornyn wants energy, environment compromise” was the AP article about this bill that ran in some papers in January, 2004. The AP made it clear it was “fierce opposition” from Democrats that stopped the bill that would have created up to “800,000” jobs. Most House Democrats voted “NO.” So did Hillary, Joe, and Chucky Schumer a few days later. Most Republicans voted for it. 2

· Another AP article reveals a third chance Congress had to help America. “Senate puts chill on Arctic drilling measure” ran in some papers in December, 2005. The bill would have opened 2,000 acres of the **1002** area in Alaska for energy production. (See the **f**ront **c**over of this pamphlet.) Plus, it would have slowed the *growth* of federal spending. Almost all Democrats said “NO” to more energy and jobs . . . including Hillary, Joe, Chucky Schumer and a new guy named Barack. (Opening this tiny area would employ people in software development, shipbuilding, steel production, and other areas across America.) EVERY Democrat (in the House and Senate) said “NO” to any limit on spending *growth*. Most Republicans voted for more energy, slowing the growth of the wasteful spending DOGE is trying to confront *right now* in 2025, and jobs. [Most Democrats said “NO” on using those 2,000 acres over and over again this century. (*Maybe they want us to push our cars?*) In 2005 they added “NO”

to any limits on spending *growth*.]

· On July 8, 2012 something incredible popped up on ABC's *This Week*. A study by Stanford University revealed this fact: President Obama's appointees to run the Commerce Department, the EPA, and other agencies **over-regulated** so much that . . . they prevented at least two million jobs from being created.

Stopping the Keystone Pipeline was one tiny ice *cube* on the gigantic ice**berg** of ways that one Democrat Administration harmed job creation over four years.

In 2017 ALL House and Senate Democrats, including (then-Senator) Kamala Harris, voted "NO" on The Tax Cuts and Jobs Act of 2017. The plan cut taxes for average Americans and was another chance to open those 2,000 acres in the **1002** area of Alaska for energy production. After it passed, The Tax Foundation discovered that this Republican plan cut taxes of the working poor by \$4 billion and of the middle class by \$31 billion in 2018. (The wealthiest among us actually paid more than before the act passed.) See Andy Puzder's "The truth about Trump's tax cuts . . ." which was updated on November 1, 2020. (It's on the finance.yahoo site.)**3**

How well did this plan help our economy? It worked well with the activities of the White House. The Republican Administration cut useless regulations. [See those two million jobs from 2012. (above)] On October 6, 2019 NBC's *Meet the Press* reported that we had the lowest unemployment rate in fifty years!
